

Fancy Being a Millionaire

What is it?

The supreme multiple-choice test of general knowledge.

An evening of excitement based on the famous television game show- presented by our host, who will be fully armed with catchphrases and questions to help guide and misguide the contestants...

"Is that your final answer?"

How does it work?

Contestants face fifteen general knowledge questions. Each question has four answer options, though only one is correct. Questions begin simply, and increase in difficulty as the game progresses.

The aim of the quiz is to correctly answer all questions. Each right answer equates to an amount of fun money, with the latter questions worth more and the fifteenth question worth £1 million. An incorrect answer will mean game over for the contestants, although they start the game with three 'lifelines' to aid them.

Fancy Being a Millionaire can be played individually, or as a team based game. The host invites one team/player onto the stage to tackle the challenge at any one time. Teams nominate one spokesperson to answer questions.

With questions displayed in turn on monitors around the room, contestants tackle the quiz by giving the host their answers. The host adds to the excitement and nail biting pressure by teasing contestants with stalling techniques and phrases to make them doubt their answers. If contestants are unsure about any question, they can use one or more lifelines.

Fifty-Fifty

The computer randomly eliminates two incorrect answers

Ask the Audience

The contestant asks the audience which answer they believe is correct. Members of the audience indicate their choices using a keypad. The results of the audience vote is immediately displayed on the contestant's and host's screens.

Phone a Friend

We recommend that the player selects one colleague in the audience. The contestant has thirty seconds to read the four choices to the friend, who selects an answer before the time runs out.

Fancy Being a Millionaire is flexible, and questions can be based on general knowledge or tailored to your business/company.
